**INFORMATION FOR CANDIDATES ADVERTISEMENT NO.2 (iv)**

1. Applications must be submitted on the prescribed form alongwith the sheet of additional questions duly completed. Application forms must reach the Secretary, Haryana Public Service Commission, Bays No. 1-10, Block-B, Sector-4, Panchkula on or before the close of office working hours on the last date for receipt of application forms failing which these shall be rejected. Non-furnishing of documents in support of qualifications/experience or submission of incomplete application form shall render the candidate ineligible.
2. These posts are temporary. The posts are covered under Contributory Pension Scheme.
3. The selected candidate must be prepared to join duty immediately after selection.
4. **Scale of Pay:** - Rs.PB-2 Rs.9300-34800+Rs.4200 G.P.
5. **Essential Qualifications:** -
  - I. a) B.Sc. of recognized University with Zoology as one of the subject.
  - b) Post graduate Training in fisheries from Central Inland Fisheries Research Institute Barrackpore, Calcutta with 3 years practical experience of fisheries Development programme in a Govt./Semi Govt./Public Undertaking.

Or

7 years experience in fisheries Development after attainment of basic qualification in a Govt./Semi Govt./ Public Undertaking.

Or

II. a) M.Sc Zoology with Specialization in Fish and Fisheries.

b) Four Years experience in Fisheries Development after M.Sc under a Govt./Semi Govt./Public Undertaking.

Note: - The experience in each case will be counted after attaining of basic qualification.

III. Adequate knowledge of Hindi/Sanskrit.

**6. Age:** Candidate should not be below 17 years and not more than 40 years of age as on 30.06.2011.

**The upper age limit is relaxable upto 45 years for the following:**

- (a) Candidates belonging to Schedule Castes of Haryana.
- (b) Unmarried women candidates of Haryana.
- (c) Women whose husbands have been ordered by civil/criminal courts to pay maintenance to them; women whose husbands have remarried; widows; women who are legally separated from their husbands or have been divorced; women living separately from their husbands for more than two years because of desertion; wives of serving disabled military personnel and widows of those who were killed in action. Women living separately from their husbands due to desertion will be required to submit with her application, an affidavit to the effect that she has been deserted by her husband and has been living separately from him for more than two years and this affidavit should be countersigned by two responsible persons such as members of the Legislatures, Local Bodies including Panchayats and the Bar Association where however, a woman who has re-married she would not be eligible for the above concession in the matter of age.
- (d) The persons recruited from 1-1-1963 onwards as whole time Cadet Instructors in the N.C.C. and who are released after the expiry of their initial/extended tenure will also be entitled for relaxation in age limit for purpose of employment under the State Government. The period of service rendered by them in N.C.C. may be deducted from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the prescribed upper age limit of a particular post by more than three years, they

may be deemed to be satisfying the conditions for appointment to that post in respect of the maximum age. Such of the whole time Cadet Instructors in N.C.C. who are released from the N.C.C. before expiry of their initial / extended tenure would also be given these concessions subject to the conditions that they have served in the N.C.C. for the period of not less than six months prior to their release from the N.C.C.

6. The candidates serving under Union/State Govt. will not be allowed any benefit of their past service under their respective Govt.

**7. Duties:-**

- (1) To be incharge of Fisheries Development activities at the District level.
- (2) To conserve and argument natural Fisheries in the notified waters.
- (3) To organize Development programme for increased Fish Production by improvement/reclamation of derelict water area.
- (4) To prepare plans & estimates for improvement of village ponds.
- (5) To be responsible for implementation of plan & non plan scheme in the area under his control.
- (6) To be responsible for proper utilization of Govt. funds placed at his disposal strictly in accordance with P.F.R.
- (7) To have proper administration on control over the ministerial and Technical staff working under him.
- (8) To be responsible for collection, maintenance and supply of all sorts of information in respect of Fisheries Development Activities within his jurisdiction.
- (9) To be responsible for raising Govt./revenue from Fisheries Resources both from the notified waters as well as village ponds.
- (10) To act as Drawing and Disbursing officer Class-II.

**Note:-**1. The eligibility of candidates with regard to qualifications and experience etc is to be determined on 30.06.2011.

2. Incomplete application from i.e. without proof of age and minimum required qualifications etc. will be straightway rejected without entering into any correspondence.

3. Attested copies of original certificates should be attached as evidence in support of the claim.
