OUT OF WHICH 44 POSTS ARE RESERVED FOR SCHEDULED CASTES OF HARYANA, 16 POSTS ARE RESERVED FOR BACKWARD CLASSES OF HARYANA, 12 POSTS ARE RESERVED FOR EX-SERVICEMEN OF HARYANA AND 7 POSTS ARE RESERVED FOR PHYSICALLY HANDICAPPED OF HARYANA ONLY.

INFORMATION FOR CANDIDATES TO ADVT. NO.

1. (i) Applications must be submitted on the prescribed form attached herewith together with the enclosed sheet of additional questionnaire duly completed and must reach the Secretary, Haryana Public Service Commission, Bays No. 1-10, Block-B, Sector-04, Panchkula, not later than the closing date mentioned above. **APPLICATION MUST REACH COMMISSION'S OFFICE BY CLOSE OF OFFICE WORKING ON LAST DATE FOR RECEIPT OF APPLICATION FAILING WHICH THESE SHALL BE REJECTED. NON-FURNISHING OF DOCUMENTS IN SUPPORT OF YOUR QUALIFICATIONS AND AGE etc. OR SUBMISSION OF INCOMPLETE APPLICATION FORM SHALL RENDER THE CANDIDATE INELIGIBLE.**
 - (ii) A passport size of his/her recent photograph duly signed on the front by the candidate should be pasted on the first page of the application form.
 - (iii) The Physically Handicapped person having atleast 40% disability are exempted from the payment of Examination/application fee on the production of a Medical Certificate from a Civil Surgeon certifying that the applicant is Physically Handicapped and also the nature of the handicap

and that he is unfit for normal active work, Ex-Servicemen are also exempted from the payment of application fee. Such person will, however, have to pay the cost of the application form.

2. The posts are in Haryana Veterinary Service Class-II. These posts are temporary, but likely to continue. These posts are pensionable as per Haryana New Pension Scheme.
3. The period of probation is 2 years. If the work and conduct during the probation period is in the opinion of Government not satisfactory or if the post is abolished or for any other reasons there is a lack of vacancy in the cadre to which appointment is now being made, service will be terminated without notice.

After the expiry of the period of probation which would mean its satisfactory completion in the opinion of Govt. Service will be terminated on one month's notice or by paying one month's pay in lieu thereof on either side. In case the candidate wished to leave the job during the period of probation he can do so by giving one month's notice or by depositing his one month's pay in lieu thereof to Govt.

4. The selected candidates will be required to pass a Departmental Examination prescribed for HVS Class-II Officer within the prescribed period.
5. **Scale of Pay** : (a) PB-II Rs.9300-34800/- with an initial pay of Rs. 14800/- + Rs. 5400/- G.P.
(b) PB-III Rs. 15600-39100+Rs. 6000/- G.P.
(after 5 years of regular satisfactory service in the Cadre).
(c) PB-III Rs. 15600-39100+Rs. 7600/- G.P.
(After 11 years of regular satisfactory service limited to 20% of the cadre Post) .
6. **Qualification Essential:**
 - (i) Bachelor of Veterinary Sciences and Animal Husbandry from a recognized University or Institute.
 - (ii) Adequate knowledge of Hindi/Sanskrit.

- (iii) Registered Veterinary Practitioner with Haryana Veterinary Council or with any Veterinary Council in India or Indian Veterinary Council as required by Indian Veterinary Council Act. 1984

Preferential :

Ph.D or Master of Veterinary Sciences in Animal Genetics and Breeding/Veterinary Gynaecology/Animal Physiology or in any branch of Animal Husbandry/Veterinary Science.

7. Person serving the Central or other State govt. will not be given the benefit of their past service.
8. The candidates selected must be prepared to join duty immediately after selection.
9. Age : 22 years to 40 years on 01.07.2010 (45 years for the Scheduled Castes of Haryana, Backward Classes of Haryana and unmarried women of Haryana only). The upper age limit is also relaxable upto 45 years for (i) Women whose husbands have been ordered by civil/criminal courts to pay maintenance to them; women whose husbands have remarried; widows; women who are legally separated from their husbands or have been divorced; woman living separately from her husband for more than two years because of desertion; wives of serving disabled military personnel and widows of those who were killed in action. Women living separately from their husbands due to desertion will be required to submit with her application, an affidavit to the effect that she has been deserted by her husband, and has been living separately from him for more than two years and this affidavit should be countersigned by two responsible persons such as members of the Legislatures, Local Bodies including Panchayats and the Bar Association. Where however, a woman who has remarried, she would not be eligible for the above concession in the matter of age.
(ii) Upper age limit is also relaxable for an ex-military person whether he joined military service before or after the declaration of emergency to the extent of his military service added by three years provided he had rendered continuous military service for a period of not less than six months before his release and further

provided that he had been released otherwise than by way of dismissal or discharge on account of misconduct or inefficiency. A disabled military person is entitled to exclude from his age the period from the date he was disabled upto the date of his application or till the end of emergency i.e. 10-1-1968.

(iii) The persons recruited from 1-1-1963 onwards as whole time Cadet Instructors in the N.C.C. and who are released after the expiry of their initial/extended tenure will also be entitled for relaxation in age limit for purpose of employment under the State Government. The period of service rendered by them in N.C.C. may be deducted from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the prescribed upper age limit of a particular post by more than three years, they may be deemed to be satisfying the conditions for appointment to that post in respect of the maximum age. Such of the whole time Cadet Instructors in N.C.C. who are released from the N.C.C. before expiry of their initial / extended tenure would also be given these concessions subject to the conditions that they have served in the N.C.C. for the period of not less than six months prior to their release from the N.C.C.

10. Duties:

- (i) Treatment of indoor and outdoor cases, attending the Veterinary Hospital.
- (ii) Ante and Postmortem Examination of live stock Slaughtered at the local slaughter house where the Municipal Committee has not the necessary staff.
- (iii) Control of contagious diseases amongst live stock
- (iv) Castration of unsuitable male livestock in the ilaqa.
- (v) Live stock breeding
- (vi) Inspection of dairy concerns and Gaushalas.
- (vii) Propaganda work relating to live stock breeding, feeding and management.

Selected person can be posted through out the Haryana State.

11. Concession of Rent Free Accommodation or House Rent Allowance in lieu thereof is admissible only to those Veterinary Surgeons who are posted at Civil Veterinary Hospital only.

12. The selected person will have prospects of promotion to HVS Class-I (SDO,AH/Equivalent post on seniority-cum-merit basis).

The eligibility of candidates with regard to qualification etc. is to be determined on the closing date.

Note :

1. Indian Postal Orders issued before the date of publication of this advertisement and after the closing date will not be accepted by the Commission.
2. Incomplete application form i.e. without proof of age and the minimum required qualifications and experience will be straightway rejected without entering into any correspondence.
3. Experience wherever prescribed acquired after the acquisition of requisite minimum qualifications will only be taken into account except where otherwise provided.
4. None of the persons mentioned below shall fall within the definition of word “Dependent of Ex- Servicemen” in terms of Haryana Govt. letter No. 12/37/79-GS-II dated 21.11.99.
 - (i) A person may be unemployed at the time of making the application but he may have other source of income viz. from agriculture, trade, property, bank balance etc.
 - (ii) A person may be working on adhoc basis on the post advertised or some where else.
 - (iii) A person who is member of Joint Hindu Family and remains dependent upon the Karta till there is partition in the family or he ceases to be a member of the Joint Hindu Family and is obliged to pass on all his income to Karta and draws money for his subsistence from the pool of the Joint Hindu Family with the consent of the Karta.
 - (iv) A candidate who is a member of the Joint Hindu Family is employed on adhoc basis but he is otherwise dependent on his father.
